SINGULAR AND PLURAL NOUNS



This time, we will study the number of nouns. We call them **singular and plural** nouns. We will also know the difference between singular nouns and plural nouns.



Let us read these examples:

1. **Bag** is to singular noun while **bags** is to plural noun.

2. **Church** is to singular noun while **churches** is to plural noun.

3. **Child** is to singular noun while **children** is to plural noun.

SINGULAR NOUN

A **singular noun** refers to only one person, place, animal, thing, and event.



PLURAL NOUN

A **plural noun** refers to more than one person, place, animal, thing and event.

COUNT NOUNS

Count nouns are nouns that can be counted as one or more. They can be counted individually.

Examples: apples, tomatoes

Mass nouns are nouns that cannot be counted separately.

Examples: rice, vinegar, soup
